SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Please review the following with your child:

Shirts/Tops – no inappropriate messages (drugs, sex, violence, etc.); nothing that reveals the midriff, breasts or navel; no spaghetti straps (straps at least 5 cm in width); if sleeveless, clothing is to fit snuggly around the shoulder and under the armpits

Pants/Skirts - will not be worn so low as to reveal underclothing or buttocks; skirts and shorts must be a minimum of mid-thigh in length.
