#### **Opening Prayer -**




#### 5. Financial Report - CSAC Budget (Mary/Lynn) - \$5531.54

- b. Lake Huron Family of Parishes video/Gr. 8 Confirmation/prayers & celebrations... we had a beautiful staff mass at the Church and an excellent Advent video was created. Lenten virtual visits with priests, Gr. 4/5 Stations of the Cross recording; Raise funds for SABTF and Blessings (food drive)
