## 1. Business arising from minutes:

**-Communication:** (topic arose from the Faye Murray presentation, as information did not reach everyone). More communication and different formats (weekly memo, messenger, facebook page, direct emails and flyers sent home in backpacks)

**-Ball diamond** : do we want to go ahead and order gravel and organize parent volunteers to prep base and make it decent? (\$500)

- Scrape down was is already there
  - Level it out and repaint lines
  - Discussion is still to be had about bases?

**-Bibles**: no printed version of the catholic adventure bible. Jen-did you get a chance to discuss with Monique about the correct one from years past? April asked Monique, and she purchased past Bibles from Walmart in the States. She has sent April a similar one.

- **Stem Resources:**: suggestions from teachers what they could benefit from (gears, electronic components, lego, magnifying glasses, hammers /nails, screws /drivers, or other) Did staff give any input at the staff meeting of what they would like to see?

**-Lego drive?** - saw it in the weekly memo once, any response? should we advertise more for this?

- Mary E. advised only the Duplo Lego was brought in the last time it was posted in the weekly memo. Not a lot came in so it was given to Peer Pals to use
- LoriLynn addressed the Lego board at the March 19, 2025 staff meeting. Staff agreed to use the \$1000 to be used for the Lego wall (thinking one central wall library?)
- Melanie L. to make up poster to advertise for Lego donations from community (Brand name Lego only)
  - Can be placed at the Post Office, Good Neighbours, Blessings, etc.

• Parents can purchase gently used Lego online (Marketplace, Kijiji) and donate to the school but school is not allowed

#### 2. Old Business

• Spirit wear: offered Dunnys order this fall- how did it go?

Melanie talked to Scott at McLeans prices very similar, talked to mary and we compared with Dunnys, a bit cheaper for some items. Mcleans does school link to online store which means parents/staff can order anytime and they print/embroider in store so pick up usually within the week! Offer more items like cinch bags, ball caps etc. Scott away this week on vacation but should hear back next week when it will be set up to review

- Feedback from people who purchased from Dunnys Good quality hoodies
- Mary advised 16 orders (families not single items) were purchased
- McLeans Scott at McLeans is going to speak with Mel next week about our school's clothing website. Mel to provide an update at next CSAC meeting
  - Does printing right in store (local Exeter)
  - Discussed keeping school's clothing website open all year round (can order on a whim)
- Vote: Spirit wear to be purchased via Dunny's or McLeans
  - McLeans = Motioned by Jenna Becker, Second Josie Webster
- Food Days: Godfathers VS Dominos results? Keep DQ or no?
  - Dominos wins voting (LoriLynn went class to class to get opinions/votes)
  - Dominos does charge \$15 delivery fee CSAC member to see if Dominos is up to discussion about waving fee
  - DQ: Mary advised there is about 4-5 students from each class that don't order DQ
    - Students seem to really enjoy DQ days
    - Keep DQ days?: always depends on if we have a volunteer to pick up orders
      - For now Mary always has someone who responds to the weekly memo about being able to pick up DQ orders
- Grade 8 Grad: Discuss the potential of grade 7 parents and students decorating for graduation. How do we initiate this?

-bake sale to cover composite, the meal, and the extra decorations

- Grade % parent group had questions What is the budget? Is there a stash of decor somewhere? Any leftover decor from previous years that can be used?
- Given \$150 budget
- Prayer service/Mass will be done at the church, diplomas/awards will be given out at the school's gym
- There will be no meal this year cake will be given out instead
- Looking at pushing graduation start time till 6pm
- LoriLynn to set up meeting with Father Tony to discuss details of graduation evening
- Music program potential -, storage, band aid grant, April looking into this: applications

now open, deadline Dec. 3, recipients notified in Spring. Can check in with church about storage in future (father is open to discuss) need to check in with Ms. Cook now she's back.

- April looking into Band Aid Grant
  - Across Canada Grant
  - Up to \$20,000 for the purchase of instruments, equipment and resources
  - They base it off of who is in need of the grant the most

- School gets a discount through Long and McQuade Music Store
- Normally board pays for rental/purchases of instruments
- Caroline Thuss Art Director at school board (see if she can put it in the budget)
  - Mel and April with the help of LoriLynn draft letter to the board explaining St. Boniface's need of an instrumental program in the school
- Another portable ?? can be sound proofed, temperature controlled, etc.
  - Music room would stay in portable students would come/go from portable instead of bringing instruments/equipment into classrooms

## • Skating:

 $\circ$  Mayor Klopp spoke with Lori Lynn- council will not charge for skating this year!

Did it get used much? Next year can we plan a school wide fun day? with skating for all grades younger in AM and older in PM and parent volunteers to accommodate the adult /child requirements on ice for the teachers who don't wish to skate. And CSAC /parent volunteers will provide Pancake Lunch (can do it for xmas spirit day with hot chocolate /candy canes AND for shrove tuesday) This will also meet the safe food prep, and kitchen space issues using the arena's kitchen facility.

- LoriLynn not sure if council will continue no charge for skating again next year
  - Jenna advised the no charge will continue "Council does not have the discussion on the docket and will continue the no charge skating for the school"
- Arena contract with school certain amount of time given to school per month to use hall in arena free of charge (April to see if she can find the contract again)
- Shrove Tuesday
  - Denver from the Municipality advised someone with their Safe Food Handling certificate must be on the arena premises at all times
  - Discuss with CWL to see if they would be interested in doing/helping out with pancakes?
    - Was also mentioned pairing/partnering up with Good Neighbours
    - We will revisit this topic again in the fall
- Discussed booking Shrove Tuesday ahead of time at the arena
